Report and Update on the UCAN United Christian Advocacy Network City Mission by Stan Collver 1st Street Jamestown, New York

The David L Woodburn Chapter of the VVA 978(Frewsburg) donated furnishings for the first homeless Veteran Room at the UCAN City Mission last year. An attractive plaque was installed outside of the room so the vet could see that it was a veterans' room provided by veterans. The room has been used much of the time since it was made available. Additional rooms on the third floor are in progress of being remodeled now. This year (2018), two additional groups have stepped up to provide rooms for homeless veterans: The PFC Joseph P. Dwyer Peer-to-Peer Group (facilitated by Cindy Reidy); ALSO, the Blue Star Mothers Lake Erie, NY Chapter 4, just voted on Saturday, April 14, to donate \$1.500 to furnish a third homeless veteran room at the mission. Typical furnishings for each room includes a bed, bedding, curtains. wall picture, plain wood chair, desk, paint, wall repairs, and sometimes refinishing the floor. The Mission is now offering a veterans' SUPPORT GROUP that meets every Saturday from 1-2 PM in the conference room. We would like to thank all those involved in these much needed programs and services at the mission. Many hands at work on these rooms help reduce the cost, so we can provide these facilities to our brothers.


